Prohibited (banned) items

The following items are not allowed in school:

- **Mobile phones** (can be brought to school but must be kept in your bag during lesson times)
- **Chewing gum**
- **Headphones** (can be brought to school but must be kept in your bag during lesson times)
- **Energy drinks**



My Child at School (MCAS)

- All parents will have recently received an activation code for **MCAS, a parental engagement app** that informs you of your child's day-to-day information such as **rewards, attendance and behaviour**
- MCAS also allows parents to input key information such as consent directly into our database – thank you to all parents who have already done this

ParentPay & School Meals

- At Telford Park School we utilise **ParentPay** for payment of school trips and events. Parents will receive an **activation code** via email during your son/daughters first week at school
