Ofsted recognises continued improvements

On a recent visit to The Telford Park School Ofsted recognised that leaders are taking effective action towards the removal of the special measures judgement. They stated that leaders have a very accurate view of where the school is on its improvement journey and acknowledged the shared leadership with The Telford Langley School is having a positive impact on standards at the school. The school was praised for its level of vigilance in keeping students safe.

Inspectors noted that there are early signs of improvement in achievement and that students on the schools reading programmes are 'making rapid gains'. Improvements in whole school 'attendance, punctuality and behaviour' were also identified.

An improvement in the quality of teaching was identified as 'pupils are given choices in their lessons about the level of challenge of and the extent of support they need'. It was noted that in lessons students are 'engaged with their learning and showing interest in the activities they are doing'. Good relationships between staff and students are a key feature also, with classrooms being calm, orderly environments.

The impact of the Community Academies Trust was praised.

We are very pleased with the outcome of this report and remain firmly committed to securing further rapid improvements to ensure the best possible outcomes academically, personally and socially for all of our students.

A special thank you to all of our parents and carers for your ongoing support, the improvements being made would not have been possible without your support.
