

Provider Access Statement

Introduction

This statement sets out the school's arrangements for managing the access of providers to pupils at the school for the purposes of giving them information about the provider's education or training offer. Management of Provider Access Requests

Opportunities for Access

Our provision includes various opportunities for students to access a range of events. These are mainly integrated into the school's careers programme and curriculum. These events are therefore delivered internally, with contribution from external providers where appropriate.

Procedure

A provider wishing to request access should contact Mr Phill Goodwin, Careers Lead, via the school's contact details.

Local providers are invited to relevant key events. In addition, external providers interested in coming into school should speak to Mr Goodwin, our schools Careers Lead, to identify the most suitable opportunity.

The school's Safeguarding Policy sets out the school's approach to allowing providers into school as visitors to talk to our students.

Resources

Once visits have been agreed, the school will provide appropriate rooming to facilitate the visit, along with any equipment requested by the provider, where it available.

Providers are welcome to leave a copy of their prospectus or other relevant course literature at the school reception. The literature will be then passed to the Careers Lead for appropriate display in an accessible place within school.

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
